# Parent/Coach Sideline Conduct

## AYSO Region 180



### Parent/Coach Pledge

- ❑ I will respect referees/coaches & their authority during practices/games & will never question, discuss or confront them at the game field but will instead speak with them at another agreed upon time/place
- ❑ I will remember that referees are developing their skills, that not every call will go my way, that this is not the World Cup, that referees are volunteering their time and deserve my gratitude
- ❑ I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games/practices unless I am one of the OFFICIAL team coaches
- ❑ I will refrain from directing my child's play on the field, i.e. telling them where to stand, where to run, who to pass to
- ❑ I will remember that players are learning the game and developing skills and too many voices from the sidelines make that process difficult, stressful and less fun
- ❑ I will cheer for my player and his/her teammates & respectfully celebrate great plays & player efforts
- ❑ I will model good sportsmanship and respect for the game so that players can learn from my good example

## AYSO Region 180 Volunteer Points System



### Purpose:

- To create a well-run, robust program that provides the best soccer experience for our players & families
- To replenish our Volunteer pool, particularly referees
- To support tournament play for all players & post-season play for those who want to play past Fall Core Season

**10U and above 25 Points required to qualify for end to your tournament**

**8U 15 Points required to qualify for end to your tournament**

Item	Points	Description
Head Coach	Required	Complete Certification/Training
Referee	Required	Complete Certification/Training
Referee Games – 8U	1	Points per game refereed
Referee Games – 10U+ AR	2	Points per game refereed signed up ahead of time. -1 if day of the game
Referee Games – 10U+ Center	3	Points per game refereed signed up ahead of time. -1 if day of the game
Hospitality Tent	1	1pt/parent/hour
Field Setup	1	2 adults, 1 hour
Field Teardown	1	2 adults, 1 hour
Field Painting	1	2 adults, 2-3 hours
